**Declaration** boxes will be opened at 10:30 a.m. on **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2011.**

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. No entry shall be received for any race except upon condition that it shall be subject to the rules of Racing of the Royal Calcutta Turf Club and the General Conditions as published in this Prospectus and that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of such entry and/or the start and/or the running and/or the result of the race as in all other races under the Rules of this Club shall be referred to/decided by the Stewards and their decision shall be final.

2. Unless already registered under R C T C, R W I T C, M R C, B T C or H R C Rules, horses must be registered and rated with the Handicapper, R.C.T.C., otherwise entries will be refused.

EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE SPECIFIED NO HORSE SHALL BE ENTERED IN ANY RACES OTHER THAN THOSE FOR THE CLASS IN WHICH IT IS RATED BY THE HANDICAPPER, R C T C.

The list of entries shall be closed at the time appointed and no entry shall be admitted on any ground after the time except horses becoming eligible to enter after closing of entries for a handicap race only may be entered after the revised ratings are published. For Terms races with a final entry clause, entries may also be accepted as advertised.

In the event of a handicap race, which is a Sweepstakes race, horses becoming eligible to enter after closing of entries may be entered by a certain date to be advertised on full payment of entry fee and / or forfeits.

3. When a horse becomes ineligible to run in a race for which the entries have already closed, the entry fee already paid in such a case will be refunded.

4. The rating of a horse shall be determined by the Handicapper from time to time. Any appeal against his decision, must be made in writing to the Secretary of the meeting for reference to the Stewards of the Club.

**5. The change in the rating of a horse in any race subsequent to the publication of handicaps for any other race for which such horse has entered, shall not be published before the Final Forfeits for that race.**

**6. To qualify for entry, Horses must be rated atleast 2 days prior to the closing of entries by the Handicapper, R.C.T.C. Such Horses which leave station to race at other centres, fresh ratings should be obtained from the Handicapper R.C.T C on their return to Kolkata.**

Applications for allotment of ratings under the R.C.T.C. Rules of Racing must state the date, rating, centre and where the horse has last raced. If the horse is unraced, the age and sex must be stated.

7. No horse shall be entered in any race other than those for which it is eligible unless otherwise mentioned in the conditions of the race.

8. Horses which have raced at meetings other than those conducted under the R.C.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to the allotment of ratings by the Handicapper, R.C.T.C. must be re-rated by the Handicapper, R.C.T.C. prior to closing of entries for any Handicap Races under these Rules. Entries for any Handicap race for which application for allotment of rating has not been received, may be refused or cancelled.

9. In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than the R.C.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to its having been entered for a Handicap Race under the R.C.T.C. Rules, the entries of such horse shall be void.

10. In the event of horses having raced at meetings other than the R.C.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to having been handicapped under the R.C.T.C. Rules, such Horses shall be withdrawn from the race even after having been Handicapped or Accepted.

11. A fee of Rs. 500/- per horse will be charged for the use of the outer portion of the Monsoon course proper from 1st May, 2011 if and when made available for 'fast work'.

12. Should circumstances arise which in the opinion of the Stewards, make it desirable; the date and time at which forfeits are advertised to fall due are liable to alterations after closing of entries.

13. a) Entries must be accompanied by a remittance for the full amount of such entries and shall state :-

- i) Race
- ii) Rating
- iii) Owner's name.
- iv) Colour, Age and Sex of Horse
- v) Horse's name and Pedigree
- vi) Trainer

13. b) The Stewards, Royal Calcutta Turf Club have decided to strictly enforce the norms governing Sweepstakes/Classic Races in that all entries for the Sweepstakes/Classic Races must be accompanied by the requisite entry fee either by Cash/Bank Draft or local Cheque or with a Transfer Sheet to cover the entry fee.

14. All Entries must be signed by the Owner/Authorised agent failing which such entries are liable to be rejected (See Rule 83).

- a) Entries should be made in the requisite forms available with the Racing Department.
- b) Except where otherwise specified if in any race there are less than seven race worthy horses entered in bonafide separate interests the race will be at the option of the Stewards.

**DIVISION OF RACES**

15. a) A race may be divided only when the number of acceptors exceeds the required number for starting. However, in the event of there being more than one such race on a race day, the race with the maximum number of acceptors shall only be divided while acceptors for each of the other races will be balloted out by drawing of lots till the required number is attained.

A horse excluded by rejection from a race shall not be excluded by rejection for a subsequent race for which it is an acceptor.

b) When a race is divided, a list of acceptors shall be first adopted, the order of which shall be the same as published in the handicap. The acceptors shall then be allotted in that order alternatively to each division. Provided that if a division contains more than one horse in the nomination of the same person, or in the care of the same trainer, the persons authorized to make the division may exchange the second of such horses with a horse of the same weight or failing such, of the nearest weight, in another division not so nominated or trained. If there be two or more of the last mentioned horses, the exchange shall be determined by lot.

c) **Safety Factor** - The max runners permitted in a race for the Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2011 is 12.

d) **Notwithstanding the above, all division of races shall be at the sole discretion of the Stewards.**

e) In the event of a race being divided into two divisions no Cup/Trophy will be given for the lower division.

16. k (i) Owners desirous of receiving money in lieu of Cups/Trophies will be reimbursed 80% of the Cup/ Trophy Value. However, this facility will not be available for advertised Sweepstakes/Terms races.

(ii) Cups/Trophies will be presented to owners without any engraving on the plaque. If the owners so desire to retain the Cup/Trophy, the engravings will be done subsequently.

17. NO SWEEPSTAKES RACE SHALL BE DIVIDED EXCEPT WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE STEWARDS, RCTC.

18. Balloting out of horses in Sweepstakes Races:-

If the number of acceptors in Sweepstakes Races, at Final Forfeits, exceeds the number of horses which can safely be started at that distance, the horses will be rejected in the following order :-

Procedure for rejection of acceptors shall be based on :

- i) The aggregate value of all Stakes earned by the horse during the current Season and preceding two seasons. Horses having **earned** higher aggregate value will be accepted and after determining the required numbers of acceptors, the remaining horses having lower aggregate value will be rejected. If two or more horses are of equal low aggregate value the horse/ horses would be rejected by ballot.
- ii) In case of Sweepstakes races confined to maidens, the rejection would be by ballot.

19. In all cases where a horse is rejected/balloted out, all entry fees and forfeits payable in respect of that horse shall be refundable. **In case of a Sweepstakes race, only the final forfeit due from such horse/s shall be refundable.**

a) In the event of a walk-over (other than a Sweepstakes Race) only half the amount of Stakes payable to the winner will be given in addition to the Cup/Trophy if any (See Rule 187).

b) The Stewards reserve the right to refuse to accept the tender of an entry and/or to cancel an accepted entry at any time without assigning a reason.

c) The Stewards reserve the right to amend or to alter the conditions of any race at any time before closing of entries.

d) The Stewards reserve the right to restrict a certain number of races for Jockeys of Indian Nationality.

20. Weights for Terms Races wherever applicable must be declared in writing to the Handicapper, RCTC not later than the date and time for final forfeits. Failure to comply with this will render the concerned person liable for disciplinary action.

21. a) The Stewards reserve the right to cancel, at any stage, a race/race day, at their sole discretion should they be satisfied that the number of entries or acceptors are, in their opinion, insufficient for that race/ race day to be viable.

b) The Stewards reserve the right to amend or alter the conditions of any race at anytime before the entry closes or to frame additional races and to indicate any race or races to be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality and Apprentices at the time of publication of acceptances.

22. **The Stewards have decided to restrict the permissible number of acceptors having similar bonafide interests in a Handicap race for horses Rated 60 to 85 and above (excluding sweepstakes races) to not more than 3 per race/per division.**

22(a) **The Stewards have decided to restrict the permissible number of acceptors having similar bonafide interests in a Handicap race for horses Rated 40 to 65 and below (excluding sweepstakes races) to not more than 2 per race/per division.**

23. All horses accepting, i.e., left in after the time for Final Forfeits must be declared to start unless prior permission for their withdrawal has been obtained from the Stewards. **No horse shall be accepted to participate in more than one race on the same day and no horse shall be accepted to participate in more than one race when racing has been scheduled for consecutive days.**

a) Unless otherwise specified, Starting Declarations for each race must be in the declaration box set apart for that race (at or before the appointed time, or if there is no such time, not later than 1200 hours on the day preceding the race).

IF, HOWEVER, BY AN ERROR, THE DECLARATION HAS BEEN PUT IN THE WRONG BOX, THE STEWARDS MAY AT THEIR DISCRETION PERMIT THE HORSE TO RUN, THE TRAINER/AUTHORISED AGENT MAY BE FINED A SUM FIXED BY THE STEWARDS OF THE CLUB FROM TIME TO TIME.

b) The declaration must be in writing and must state the name of the race, the name of the horse, weight to be carried and the name of the Jockey. Such declaration must be accompanied by the amount due for extra money for Horses not struck out, for the Jockey's fee for a losing mount, if not already paid and for any fees due. It shall also state if the horse is running shod or unshod, if the former, it shall state the description of shoes, plates or tips used. Omissions or errors in the Starting Declaration will render the owner or person making it subject to a fine at the discretion of the Stewards.

c) (It is mandatory for Owners/Trainers/Authorised Agents to comply with the R.C.T.C. Rules of Racing 110 & 126). They should ensure that the jockeys fees as for a losing mount and all outstanding amounts due by the owner are paid up before the time of declaration to start. Owners

are advised, in their own interest, to maintain their Accounts in credit. It is obligatory on the part of the Trainers to check up the accounts of the acceptors before lodging the Starting Declarations. The Stewards, R.C.T.C. will take a serious view of any noncompliance of the above instructions and take disciplinary action against the persons concerned.

24. Colours must be declared with entries unless already registered with the Royal Calcutta Turf Club.

Unregistered colours must be declared in the Club's office at or prior to the time fixed for Final Forfeits and must be of the pattern as described in the regulations governing the registration of colours as published in the Racing Calendar. Such or other approved colours must be registered with the Royal Calcutta Turf Club when notification to do so has been issued, vide Rule 119; if there be more than one horse of any one owner left in, in a race, a different coloured Cap must be declared for each horse. Every person running a horse in colours other than those registered or declared as above, will be fined in accordance with Rule 118 in respect of each horse so run. In the event of a person being unable to run a horse in colours as declared in the Race Card, the Jockey will wear 'ALL BLACK'. A set of these colours may be obtained from the Clerk of the Scales.

25. In all handicaps, a Winner of a race after the publication of weights to carry 5 kgs. extra; provided that the horse is otherwise eligible.

26. In all handicaps the lowest weight allotted shall not be less than 50 kgs.. However, the Handicapper may frame his handicaps down to weights below the permitted lowest weight wherever necessary.

27. No horse shall carry more than 2 kgs overweight in any race, except with the permission of the Stewards. Such permission must be obtained before the starting declaration box, for such race is opened.

**28. Horses which are not stationed at Calcutta will not be handicapped except for Sweepstakes Races.**

29. Owners/Trainers of outstation horses who intend to race them at this centre, must apply for stables well in advance and obtain permission in writing prior to the date of the race. Stables will be allotted at the discretion of the Stewards one week prior to the race and will have to be vacated within a week following the race.

30. Before a horse is allowed to start in a race for the first time under R.C.T.C. Rules of Racing, such horse must be produced before the Dy. G M – Veterinary Services, R.C.T.C for identification.

**31. The Stewards, RCTC have decided that all 'A' licensed trainers must have a minimum of 6 race worthy sound horses under their care failing which the defaulting Trainers would be reported to the Stewards for such action as deemed fit. Accordingly, Trainers are strongly advised to adhere to this stipulation.**

32. Calcutta based 8 years old horses which have been certified racing sound by the Sr. Veterinary Officer ,RCTC will be permitted to race in Calcutta till the conclusion of **Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2011.**

33. The Stewards have decided that the under mentioned parameters are required to be followed for allotment of stables in respect of horses arriving to participate for the Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2011 :-

- (i) 3 year old horses (foaled in 2008) would be allotted stables subject to a minimum rating of 25 at the centre where they last ran.

- (ii) 4 and 5 year old horses would be allotted stables subject to a minimum rating of 46 at the centre where they last ran.
- (iii) Horses rated 80 and above at the centre where they last raced will be allotted stables.
- (iv) Eligible outstation horses must arrive in station on or before 15.07.2011 except for those entered/left in for the following races :-
  - Calcutta Fillies Trial Stakes.
  - Calcutta Colts Trial Stakes.
  - Calcutta Monsoon Derby.
  - Monsoon Cup.

Application for the above must reach the G. M. & Advisor Racing not later than 25th June 2011.

- 34. Owners are eligible to stable NOT more than 60 racing horses (excluding 2-year-olds) during The Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2011 and not more than 60 horses (including 2-year-olds) during the Calcutta Cold Weather Season 2011-2012.
- 35. Trainers holding 'B' license will be allotted 25 racing stables (excluding 2 year olds) during the Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2011 and for the Calcutta Cold Weather Season 2011-2012, 'B' licensed trainers will be allotted 25 stables provided their list of horses includes five 2-year-olds, failing which they will be allotted not more than 20 stables.
- 36. Owners of horses stationed in Calcutta that fail to race at least thrice during the Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2011 will be penalized a sum of Rs. 5,000/- per horse.
- 37. **Stable Entry Charges.** Owners of all horses will be required to pay stable entry /arrival charge of Rs. 5,000/- per horse on arrival into the RCTC, Kolkata except horses under the charge of 'A' licensed trainers which have been permitted to leave station.
- 38. Additional 2% of all stakes will be debited to owners of horses under the charge of 'B' licensed Trainers as also to owners of out station horses under the charge of 'A' licensed trainers. This will be credited to the Club's account to meet extra expenses on infrastructure.
- 39. A further 3% of all stakes earned by the owners of outstation horses will be debited to their account and credited to the development fund of the RCTC.
- 40. Owners of outstation horses will be debited utility fee of Rs. 2,000/- per horse per month.
- 41. An incentive of 5% of the advertised stakes will be given to local owners (residing in the State of West Bengal) whose horses are under the care of 'A' licensed trainers and have placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> in a race. This will not be payable for sponsored/sweepstakes races and races where the total stakes exceeds Rs. 4.80 lakhs. The owners of outstation horses will also be given the 5% of the advertised stakes provided their horses are kept under the charge of 'A' licensed trainers. Further, there will be deduction by way of trainers and jockeys commission on the above incentive.
- 42. **Definition of an Outstation Horse** - All horses under the charge of a 'B' licensed trainer will be considered as outstation horses and any horse arriving in station after 15th July, 2011 will also be considered as an Outstation horse for that particular race meeting

excepting those that had been permitted by the Stewards of the RCTC to leave station and are returning.

43. Trainers taking leave of absence on Race Days will be required to submit their instructions to jockeys in writing, through their agents/representatives to the Clerk of the Scales prior to the start of the race. Trainers failing to do so will be fined such sum as stipulated by the Stewards.
44. The Stewards reserve the right to indicate any race/s in which Foreign Jockeys are eligible at the time of publication of Acceptances.
45. **The interpretation of any condition rest solely with the Stewards RCTC and their decision will be final and binding.**
46. The Stewards of the Club shall have the power, suomoto, to alter or modify or rescind any condition even after the publication.
